




Saint Joseph Hessen Cassel Reopening Plan

<p>Face Coverings</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *students will be required to wear facial covering when entering or leaving school and anytime social distancing cannot be attained (hallways, transitioning to class) *students with medical issues may be exempt with documentation 	<p>Moving through classes</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *students will stay with their class- teachers will change rooms as needed *seating charts will be utilized in all classroom settings *recess, art, music and PE will be outside of the classroom *masks will be required during the transitions *additional outside recess time will be used
<p>Hand washing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Students and staff will be provided ample opportunity to wash hands or use hand sanitizer *No touch paper towel dispensers have been installed in each restroom *Hand sanitizing stations have been installed at each entrance, the Monsignor Content Activity Center and the Parish Hall *students will receive training on properly washing their hands 	<p>In the Classroom</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *students will need to have their own supplies for school- shared materials will need to be disinfected between uses *PE class will be held outdoors when possible *Indoor PE class -students will be socially distanced *Families with concerns should contact the school office

<p>Social Distancing</p> 	<p>*students will be socially distanced in the classroom and all desks will face the same direction</p> <p>*Face coverings may be used in some instructional purposes such as small group or one-on-one instruction</p>	<p>Preventative Measures</p> 	<p>*Students are required to have a clean water bottle daily.</p> <p>*Cleaning of frequently touched surfaces and shared materials at least daily</p> <p>*Face mask usage when social distancing not possible</p> <p>*Water refill stations will be available but drinking fountains will be shut off</p> <p>*Bottled water will be provided at lunch</p>
<p>Cleaning/ Disinfecting</p>  <p><small>© CanStockPhoto.com - csp54327341</small></p>	<p>*All areas of frequent use will be disinfected at least once per day.</p> <p>*High touch areas may be cleaned more frequently</p> <p>*An electrostatic sprayer has been purchased and will be used daily in the school</p> <p>*No touch paper towels will replace the hand dryers in the restrooms</p>	<p>Serving Lunch</p> 	<p>*Students will wash their hands prior to going to the lunchroom</p> <p>*Lunch times will be staggered per grade</p> <p>*Students will eat in the lunch room with their class</p> <p>*Bottled water will be offered at lunch</p> <p>*Students will be assigned seating</p> <p>*Hand sanitizing station is available at the start of the lunch line</p>


*Records Day/ Back to School will utilize a schedule to limit the number of people according to the current statewide order for allowed numbers

<p>Before School monitoring</p> 	<p>*Vaccinations must be up to date before the start of school *Parents should check students for possible illness before dropping students off *Does your child have any of the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever • Cough • Sore throat • Shortness of breath • Close contact with someone positive for COVID-19 	<p>Possible CoVid-19 Symptoms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chills • Fever of 100.4 or higher • Shortness of breath • Fatigue • Coughing • Sneezing • Aches and pains • Diarrhea/vomiting • Loss of taste/smell • Sore throat
<p>Possible school closing scenarios</p>	<p>*Closings may be limited to students, classroom, school building or diocese *Identified students may be isolated/quarantined</p>	<p>Visitors to school</p>	<p>*visitors will be limited and will be required to wear a mask *parents dropping off student materials will be asked to leave the materials outside for office personnel to retrieve *parents picking up students for appointments will be required to be masked when entering the school</p>
<p>Other areas of concern</p>	<p>*Emergency drills (fire, tornado etc) will still be held *During the evacuation drill students will need to wear their masks until they are clear of the building and then follow their teachers directives *Students will need to wear mask during inside drills due to close proximity</p>	<p>Dismissal and Aftercare</p>	<p>*Families will be assigned either Door #1 or Door #2- this will be explained at Records Day *After care will be segregated by grade *After care will utilize the outdoor space as much as possible * when indoors and not socially distanced- students will need to wear masks</p>

<p>In Person</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *students stay with their class *masks worn when social distancing is not possible *Art, PE and music will be outside of classroom with extra cleaning and precautions as listed above *Lunch in the parish hall with extra precautions *Students will interact with the curriculum and with materials that may be needed in case of remote learning *Middle school teachers will change classrooms rather than the students 	<p>Remote learning</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Remote Learning will not be the same as it was this past spring. *Students will attend classes daily on a digital device (the school has some to provide) *Whole class instruction times will be set and students will need to be available to attend at those times on google hangouts *Attendance will be taken daily *The amount of instructional time and work will be the same as if attending in person *Grades will be given for work and assessments will be required
<p>Catholic Identity</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Students will attend Holy Mass 2X per week *School wide prayer (rosary) will continue with students in their classrooms *Virtue=Strength and Thrively will aid the students in faith formation *Our Catholic Faith will inform all of our decisions 	<p>Illnesses</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *if your child is ill, please keep them home- our school nurse will call to guide you through the symptoms *If your child becomes ill at school, you will need to have someone who can pick them up within an hour- they will be required to wear their mask while they are in the school
